

Global Instructor Post Available

The Nagano Prefectural Board of Education is currently seeking an experienced teacher for a Global Instructor position (hereinafter referred to as "G Instructor").

1 Position Description

In order to provide more Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) opportunities to students in Nagano Prefecture, the Nagano Prefectural Board of Education employs international residents as part-time, contract classroom lecturers with special appointments.

These lecturers, Global Instructors, will work closely with the foreign language department and other departments relating to their academic specialty at their assigned school. They will be responsible for developing curriculums for school-specific, interdisciplinary courses together with a Japanese senior high school teacher. Depending on their school placement, the Global Instructor may be asked to Team Teach (TT) with Japanese Teachers of English (JTEs) and to participate in afterschool activities such as English Debate and Presentation Contests.

2 Position Details

- (2) **Available Positions:** 1
- (3) **Placement:** Prefectural Senior High School in the Toshin (east) region of Nagano Prefecture
- (4) **Period of Appointment**

May 1, 2023 to July 31, 2023 *Contract end dates may be extended depending on the situation.

- (5) **Terms and Conditions of Appointment**

Monthly remuneration will be 285,000 yen. Other Terms and Conditions of Appointment shall be determined on the basis of TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE FOR NAGANO PREFECTURAL DIRECT-HIRE GLOBAL INSTRUCTORS. The *JET Programme Accident Insurance* will not be available.

The Nagano Prefectural Board of Education may change the Terms and Conditions of Appointment, including remuneration and position availability, if there is a reduction or loss of appropriations related to the Learning Advancement Support Division's Foreign Language Programs.

3 Qualifications and Eligibility

Applicants should:

- (1) Be currently living in or willing to relocate to the placement's municipal area
- (2) Have relevant teaching qualifications or equivalent teaching experience
- (3) Have a valid Instructor visa before the period of appointment begins. Other visa types may be considered.
- (4) Be a native English speaker or have native-level English proficiency.
- (5) Have a positive attitude towards communicating with students and coworkers at school.
- (6) Have completed any outstanding appointments with other organizations by April 30, 2023.
